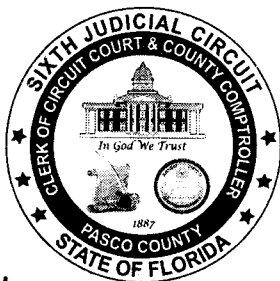

Option to Appear Telephonically – Judge Babb

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Courts are undertaking very significant measures to ensure the health of everyone involved in the court system, however, there are still certain critical court proceedings that must occur. Statutes, due process, and The Florida Supreme Court require that these include the return hearings on domestic, dating, sexual, repeat and stalking injunctions. Your injunction case has been set for a return hearing as indicated in the paperwork you have received. **You must wear a face mask and you will be instructed to sit in a designated area to comply with social distancing requirements in the courtroom.**

PLEASE NOTE: Although you may personally appear for this hearing and bring any witnesses and evidence with you, you also have the option to appear via Zoom or telephonically through Zoom. Should you wish to appear via Zoom, please email: ufce1@jud6.org.

You must send the email requesting a Zoom or Telephonic Zoom hearing at least two days in advance of your hearing.

It is important that you leave your name, case number and a telephone number you can be reached at in your email message. You will receive a return email in advance of your hearing providing you with the Zoom information to connect with the Judge on the date and time of your scheduled hearing.

If you opt to appear by Zoom or telephonically by Zoom, any other evidence you intend to present at the return hearing, such as emails, texting correspondence, photographs, police reports, etc., will need to be emailed to the following email address **at least two days prior to the hearing: ufce1@jud6.org.**
